Transportation:

- Sidewalks – Estimated cost is \$57 per metre, not including labour if public works staff install the sidewalks
- Contractor prices have been requested and will be available Friday
- Snow removal is still taking place

Environmental Health and Welfare:

- Landfill needs to be pushed and will be done once snow removal is complete
- Consider changing the way we charge outside agencies or municipalities for the use of the landfill. Look at a solid waste management fee which would include recycling costs

Water and Wastewater:

- No issues with drinking water
- Lagoon – Installed new aerator motor, will be up to 3 in a few weeks
- Effluent Irrigation at Outlook and South of Moose Jaw by Sask Water – should be investigated for new sewage treatment plant
- Sewage back-up on James Street South will cost about \$3,500.00. Some root problems around there and it is on clay tile section of the main sewer. A crack shows in the video of the sewer line. Can put in epoxy liner in the line about ½ inch thick. This solution shouldn't affect the flow because it never fills up. Dave will be obtaining a quote.
