

TOWN OF LUMSDEN
MINUTES OF THE GROUP II MEETING HELD ON
MAY 27TH, 2010

The Group II Committee convened their monthly meeting in River Park Centre in Lumsden, on the afternoon of Thursday, May 27th, 2010 at 3:58 p.m. with Chairperson Rhonda Phillips presiding.

Transportation:

- Conditions are too wet to work on sidewalks; it will take 2 weeks to dry up so sidewalks can be done.
- Crack sealing on hold; it needs to be dry and about 10 C
- Signs for handicapped parking need to be ordered
- 4 parking signs (Parking by Permit Only) to be installed on the south side of Great Gusto Enterprises building; need to order signs
- Mudjacking sidewalks in front of Maudi's and another area as well to start soon – work being done by Ground Zero
- Dust control for James Street South is scheduled for June 11th

Environmental:

Planning for downtown park:

- Move trees on bobcat trailer
- Roy Borgmann will be contacted re: use of tree spade to remove trees from nursery
- Fir & other conifers from Water Treatment to the cemetery
- Conifers & green ash from tree nursery also to cemetery
- Budget of \$7,000 for cemetery
- Tree auger ordered from Bobcat Regina (347-7600) approximately \$1,600 plus tax (shouldn't arrive until June 7th). Money to come out of tree budget (had \$10,000 but \$5,000 has been committed to tree/branch removal)
- Park has a budget of \$7,500 some of which will go to staff wages
- Some spruce to downtown park for winter particularly Town Christmas Tree
- Students will mark out where trees will go as soon as possible so holes can be drilled around June 10th; will use stakes with fluorescent paint and a map
- Park plan will be available/complete by June 4th
- Students to consider a winter gathering place in park plans and should plan a space for a fire pit
- Top soil will be hauled over from Town yard as soon as it is dry

Water & Sewer:

- Johns' should have work complete by June 1st; Wayne to go next step at that time
- Contract out completion

Lagoon:


- Very full, literally inches to the top
- Dave will likely talk to Ministry of Environment soon if rain keeps up and water levels continue to rise
