NOTE: Ratepayers who have taxes in arrears are not eligible to participate in our dust control program (as per resolution of Council).

I hereby authorize the R.M. of Lumsden No. 189 to apply liquid calcium chloride dust control product adjacent to my yard site (maximum 500 feet). I acknowledge the municipality will subsidize the costs of application of the product on a 50/50 cost-share basis up to a maximum amount of \$450.00 (\$0.90/linear ft). I acknowledge that I am responsible for 100% of any additional application costs that may be in excess of the stated \$450.00.

Note: An estimated cost of treating a 500 foot section is approximately \$900.00 (\$100 for preparation, \$650 for product and \$150 for custom application). Application fees may vary depending on location, road surface, etc.

Furthermore, I understand that any unpaid costs relating to the application of dust control, by December 31st will be added to the tax roll of the above parcel of land to form taxes against the property.

Recommended Dust Control Policy for the RM of Lumsden # 189

After reviewing various policy options for an enhanced dust control service for the municipality, the Dust Control Committee recommends the following:

1. The RM should provide an expanded dust control service for 2010 on a trial basis.
2. During this trial year, the RM's dust control service should be given preference to sites adjacent to Class 4 or 5 roads. Priority should be given to heavy haul and high volume roads (or road segments) as identified by the Councillor for each Division, based on a common set of criteria (eg., minimum traffic count, distance of dwelling from road, etc.)
3. Calcium chloride should be used.
4. For each eligible site, the RM would be responsible for preparing a maximum 500 foot section of road and covering 50 per cent of the total cost including preparation, product and application costs, to a maximum of \$450 per site. For calcium chloride the total cost of treating a 500 foot section is estimated to be approximately \$900 (\$100 for preparation, \$650 for product and \$150 for custom application).
5. For 2010 the maximum budget for dust control should be set at \$9,000. This would allow us to service a maximum of 20 sites. If more than 20 applications are received, council reserves the right to prioritize the applications at their discretion.
6. This policy should be reviewed and revised, as necessary, at the end of 2010, based on the experience gained.
