

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN No. 189

BYLAW NO. 06-2009

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON THE ROAD COMMONLY KNOWN AS
OLD HIGHWAY NUMBER 54.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Definitions:

(a) "highway" means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area; as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, 2004.

(b) "motor vehicle" means a vehicle propelled or driven by any means other than by muscular power; as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1 of the Statutes of Saskatchewan, 2004.

2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 60 km per hour on the highway located on the north portion of southeast of section 4, the northeast of section 4 and the east side of section 9, township 21, range 22, west of the second meridian (SE & NE 4, E9 21-22-W2).
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing.

Readings

Read a first time this 13th Day of August 2009.

Read a second time this 10th Day of September 2009.

Read a third time this 10th Day of September 2009.
